Parent Forum gives parents and carers a voice and enables views to be taken seriously and acted upon. It works by having a class representative who takes on board the concerns of other parents and brings those concerns to the meeting, where, collectively, a solution is found. In the event of more than one parent/ carer coming forward, they will share the duties.

Fundraising Committee

The Fundraising Committee is currently made up of the following staff members: Mr Oliver, Mrs Parry and Mrs Weaver and the following parents: Sonia Sheen, Sarah Edwards and Sarah Owen. If you would like to put yourself forward as parent rep on the Fundraising Committee, please complete the form that will come home with your child and return it to school no later than Wednesday 25th September. The fundraising committee meet when required to plan school fundraising events. After the basic planning stage, <u>ALL</u> parents and carers are invited to help run events and all who wish to help will be granted the opportunity.

<u>Snack</u>

Snack is provided for all foundation phase children at a cost of £1 per week whilst children in the juniors should bring their own healthy snack. Snack money can be sent in on a Monday morning in a named envelope or paid on the School Gateway App. Due to Welsh Government directives, crisps and chocolate are not allowed. We recommend that children bring in a piece of fruit if possible.

Breakfast Club

Breakfast Club costs 50p per day per child (with a maximum of £1 for families) and operates from 8-8.45am. Children from Nursery to Year 6 are warmly welcomed and our experienced staff offer a wide range of fun activities as well as a healthy breakfast to start the day.

School Uniform

Please ensure your child has a full PE kit in school every day, this can be left in school and sent home for washing during half term.

Attendance

The importance of attending school every day on time and to the end of the school day cannot be stressed enough. Missing even 10 minutes of the school day can mean your child is missing vital aspects of their learning. Thank you for working with us to ensure your child attends everyday on time and doesn't leave before the end of the day. Where possible medical appointments should be made out of school hours to avoid disruption and holidays are discouraged during term time.
